Leola's Life Journey

Elder Leola Pickens Norman, daughter of the late Remus and Leona Keyes Pickens was bom March 6, 1931 in Greenwood, Mississippi. Leola was the devoted wife of John Walter Norman for 47 years who predeceased her in 2009. A compassionate loving mother of Johnita and John Norman III, she became her children's role model, exhibiting godly principles, exemplary character, and a strong faith in God. She had a special adoration for her one and only grandchild, Jade Alexis Norman.

Elder Leola Norman was a loyal, dedicated and supportive member of Cross Street Christian Church for over 50 years where she served in many capacities: Deacon, Elder, Christian Education Chair, VBS Director, Sunday School Teacher, and Christian Women Fellowship. While in Canton, Ohio, Leola was the Federated Women's Club Youth Director.

Leola received her early education in Greenwood, Mississippi. Upon receiving a National Science Foundation Scholarship, she attended Ohio State and pursued advanced studies in science at UALR, UAPB, and Boston University. She earned her Bachelor of Science degree from Alcorn A&M, Mississippi and her Master's degree from Washington University, St. Louis. Leola's teaching career covered a span of forty years. She taught in Mississippi, Ohio, Colorado, and in the Little Rock School District at Parkview Magnet and Hall High Schools. During her teaching career, Leola received numerous awards: Star Teacher Award-MS Industrial Council, Stephens Award, Pulaski Heights Lions Club Teacher Hall of Fame, and Science Teacher Extraordinaire presented by the CTA. She was a member of the NEA and the CTA, Arkansas Retired Teachers Association, and the Retired Educators of Little Rock. Leola retired in 1995. She has made a tremendous impact upon the lives of many students.

Not only was Leola a veteran educator, but she served in numerous capacities with various community organizations. She was a 67 year Diamond Life Member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. Her commitment to scholarship, service, and sisterhood was evident in the numerous committees upon which she served. Her greatest love was serving on Health Careers and the Educational Development Committee, (P.A.R.K. Outreach). She received the Delta of the Year Award and the Delta Dear Award. She also received the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity Appreciation Award. Leola was a faithful and committed servant of God who extended her love to the many lives she touched. 
